FACILITIES WITHIN PARK

- Lenore Martinez Park consists of playground equipment in sand, includes slides, tubes, climbing chain and monkey bars, swings, climbing doom and sand diggers. Park includes two picnic tables with gazebos, with one grill.
- Bobby Binon Basketball Courts are four regulation size goals, which make two basketball courts available through summer for use by Community Members and surrounding Communities. Courts were resurfaced with colorful designs, and reconstructed with post-tensioned to prevent cracking of courts.
- Vicente Montano Baseball Field includes two dugouts available for use by local women's softball teams, used by Little League Teams for practice and round-robin tournament play.

ACTIVITIES OFFERED

- Swimming pool open five days a week.
- Annual Christmas Santa Claus with gifts and pictures with Santa.
- Annual Easter egg hunt with a visit from the Easter Bunny.
- Annual Recreation and Summer Food Service Programs:

Recreation Program is for children 5 to 12 years of age and runs first week of June to July 31, Monday thru Thursday 10:00am to 3:00pm. Free of Charge and Lunch program is for children 1 to 18 years of age and runs Monday thru Friday 11:30am to 1:00pm.

- Other sites serviced by the Rio Arriba County Recreation Department Summer Food Service Program are T.A. Save The Children Program, T.A. 21st Century, Chama Save The Children, Chama 21st Century, and Canjilon 21st Century.

Local teams and organizations are authorized to utilize facilities for practice or regular scheduled games. There is a process that teams need to follow. Team manager's should contact the Recreation Department or stop by office and fill out a Field Request use form and a liability waiver form.
