Rio Arriba County Requirements for Private Burial Grounds

1. Complete Dedication of Burial Ground Form.
2. Copy of recorded Warranty Deed (showing proof of ownership) this may be obtained through the County Clerk's Office.
3. Copy of recorded Survey Plat, this may be obtained at the County Clerk's Office. If the survey plat was not recorded, it is still required. If a survey plat does not exist, the Deed showing proof of ownership may be used.
4. Burial Sites may be shown on the survey plat. (Exhibit to Dedication of Burial Ground Application Form) **OR**
5. A site plan showing all improvements on the property i.e. buildings, driveways, well, septic tanks, etc., also including the burial site. (Exhibit to Dedication of Burial Ground Application Form)
6. Signed and notarized Dedication of Burial Ground Form.
7. Items 4-6 are required to be filed with the Rio Arriba County Clerk when submittal is approved. Rio Arriba County Clerk fees are \$9.00 for the first page and \$2.00 for each additional page. Our office will collect these fees at the time of submittal and will send to Tierra Amarilla for recording.
8. There is a \$ 30.00 application fee. This is due at the time of submittal. All checks made payable to Rio Arriba County.

SETBACKS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

A burial site must be set at a minimum of 25 feet from any lot line or easements on the property.

A burial site must be set at a minimum of 100 feet from any water source. Including but not limited to irrigation ditches, streams, rivers, ponds, leach fields and wells (this also includes a neighbor's water source).
