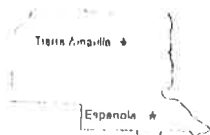

RIO ARRIBA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO 1993-03

AN ORDINANCE OF RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, PRESCRIBING
STANDARDS FOR COUNTY ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO ARRIBA
COUNTY:

Section 1. Standards for County Roads in Rio Arriba County
are as follows:

(a) County Roads shall be of a minimum right of way width
of forty (40) feet wide with roadside ditches, and shall be
thirty (30) feet wide with curb and gutter;

(b) Surfacing shall be of six (6) inch base coarse,
granular pit run base to be sandy and non-plastic;

(c) Drainage easements shall be provided along both sides
of the road; drainage easements shall be at least fifteen (15)
feet wide along an arroyo; culverts shall be installed at
irrigation ditches and drainage ways, and shall be of a size to
fit the need in each particular case;

(d) The minimum length of a county road shall be one-fourth
($\frac{1}{4}$) of a mile and must serve at least five (5) residences,
otherwise, a county road shall serve at least ten (10)

residences in a mile length.

(e) Existing County Roads will be grandfathered in and will not be affected by this Ordinance.

Section 2. After consultation with the County Manager, residents of Rio Arriba County may petition the County Commission requesting the acceptance of a particular road.

Section 3. After receipt of the petition requesting the acceptance of a road, the County Commission shall appoint a committee, pursuant to law, to view the road and report its recommendation to the Commission.

Section 4. Before acting upon the request and recommendation, the Commission shall receive and consider the advice of the County Engineer, the County Attorney, the County Road Superintendent, and other County staff as may be necessary or applicable.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective after publication as required by law.
