Request for Quote PI/Researcher

Rio Arriba County Health and Human Services Department is seeking quotes from qualified researchers to support its opioid prevention and intervention efforts. The successful offer will collaborate with relevant partners as well as utilize their skillset and knowledge to advance the following scope of service:

- PI will provide leadership to 3 student researchers (hired at a rate of .50FTE) at NNMC to explore factors impacting substance use amongst young adults in Rio Arriba County
- PI will work with project team to develop qualitative and quantitative data gathering tools
- PI will spearhead the design of research study to advance project goals
- PI will mentor student researchers to equip them with skills needed to undertake research activities
- PI will spearhead submission of two research articles for publication (in collaboration with RACHHS and NNMC) that centers around substance use and prevention strategies in Rio Arriba County
- PI will meet regularly with student researchers to discuss and advance project goals
- PI will meet monthly with project team (HHS Director, NNMC president, and all relevant parties) to discuss project development
- PI will complete and submit all IRB applications/forms needed for project implementation
- PI will engage in all other activities needed to advance project scope
